Considering the increasing demand and shortage of highly trained front-line healthcare professionals in Pakistan, CCI is offering high-demand healthcare certifications, with scholarships for deserving students from underprivileged families.

These programs are licensed/endorsed by the City & Guilds (U.K) and the premier certification agencies of Govt of Pakistan and Government of Sindh. Recruitment is selective and based on entrance exam to improve the quality of intake. That is why we have an industry topping placement rate between 82% to 90% for our programs.

SKILLS DEVELOPMENT AT CCI MAKES OUR STUDENTS UNIQUE

CCI enrolled students, learn the following aspects of technical and soft skills that are distinctive advantages in job placement alongside 3 months of professional on-the-job training:

1. HANDS-ON SKILLS TRAINING AND WORK PLACEMENT OF CCI STUDENTS

Practical skills are a core component of healthcare training, CCI has partnered with well-known public and social sector hospitals like Sindh Institute of Child Health, Hamdard University Hospital, Chiniot Mother & Child, and Burhani Hospitals (see Appendix II), to ensure all our graduates participate in a practical apprentice program for three months as a part of their training.

Pursuant to this 3-month practical training experience, CCI students obtain a solid and respectable career base, which is why our alumni are employed at reputable public and private healthcare facilities across Pakistan.



The work placement ratio of CCI graduates is high, c. 90% of our graduates scored a job within three months of graduation. 60% of the last batch of Nursing Assistants got **hired within one month of graduation**.

A key component of attractiveness of CCI graduates is their certified and recognized qualifications by leading government and private certification agencies.

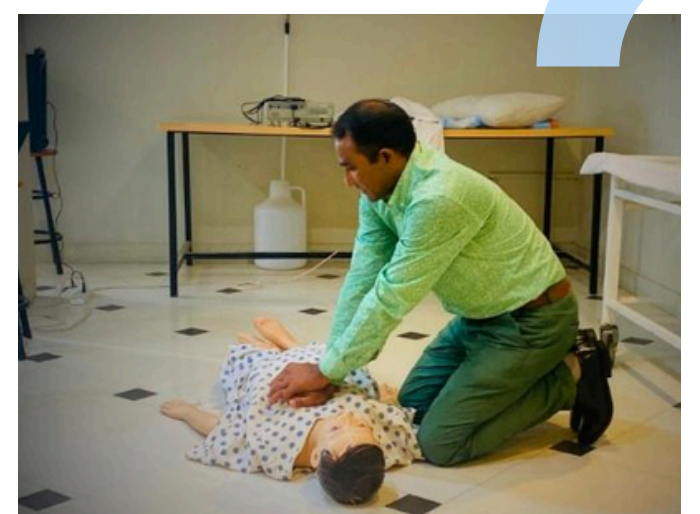
2.CCI RECRUITMENT CRITERIA

CCI recruits almost **50:50 male and female students** every year. The minimum criterion for CCI recruitment is Matriculation in science, however **Intermediate students are preferred**. Successful candidates will have good primary and secondary education with passing **grades of A or B**.

We conduct **written tests and interviews of successful candidates** to ensure high-quality students.

3.ADVANCED TEACHING METHODS

At CCI all students are instructed and trained by using a variety of new innovative as well as established teaching methods, from traditional classroom methodology to IT-based tools and content, such as **videos and presentations**, as well as **hands-on, interactive practical skills training**.

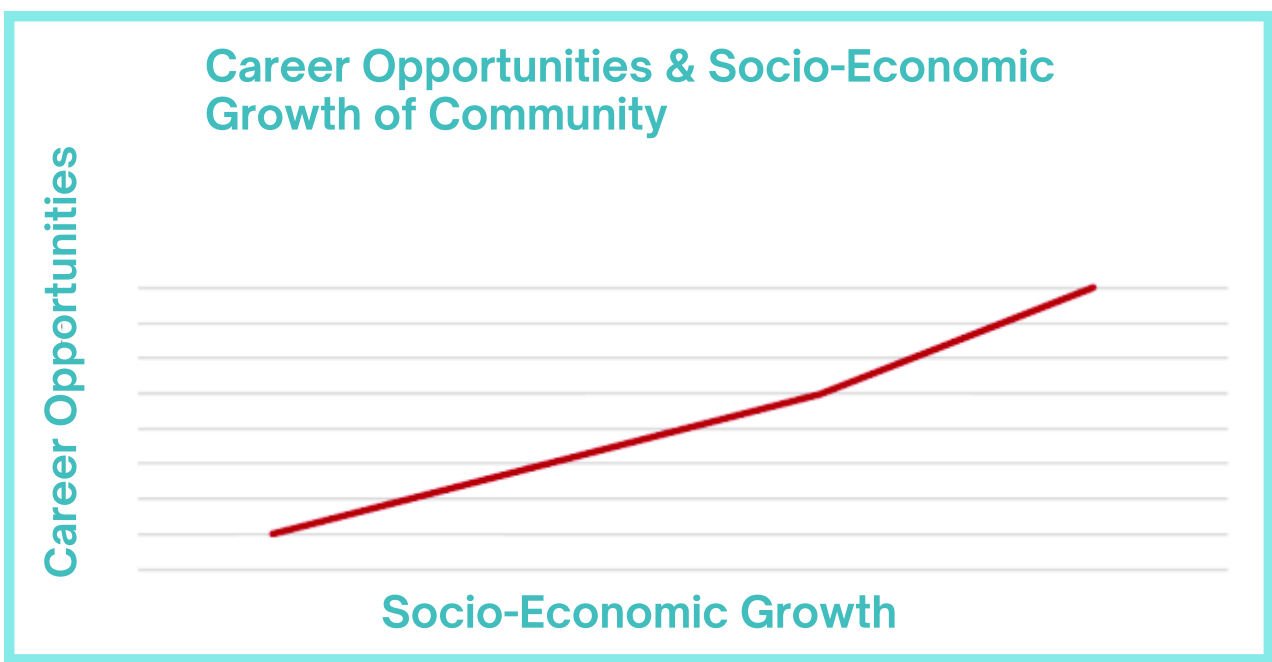


CCI CREATES CAREER OPPORTUNITIES & SERVES HEALTHCARE NEEDS OF COMMUNITIES



CCI is training quality front-line healthcare providers, creating career opportunities to meet the healthcare needs of underserved communities.

We are training our students in a high-quality practical-based curriculum that results in work placement of graduates in their own community clinics or hospital facilities. This initiative will result in youth employment, public health improvement & social economic growth.



As an aspect of our goal to train top-quality healthcare professionals, CCI chose a second batch of 58 young men & women from underserved communities in Baldia, Landhi, Korangi, and Jamshed Town with deeply inspiring stories for our Nursing Assistant program, and another 46 young ambitious boys for EMT and 24 students both male and female from Home Health Care Giver. Our objective is to drive socioeconomic impact and transformation of communities through meaningful employment of our graduates at good wages and healthcare service to the community.

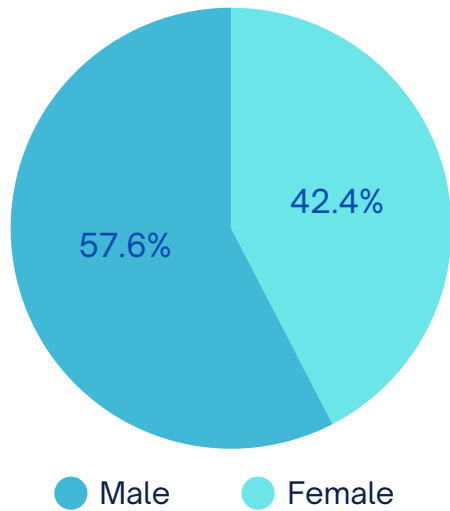
Malaika Abdul Hameed

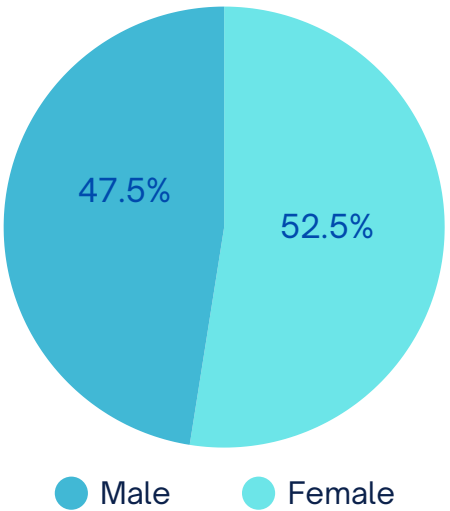

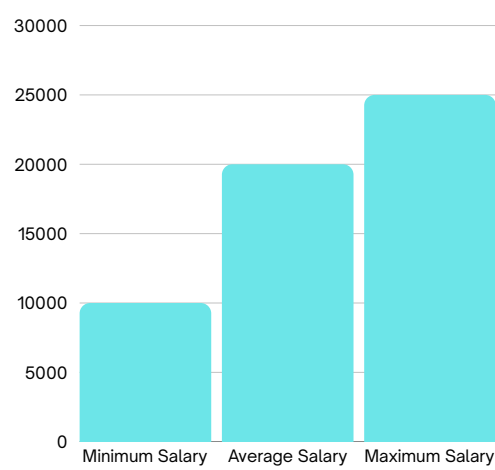
GENDER BREAKDOWN
Nursing Assistant 1 (FY2023)



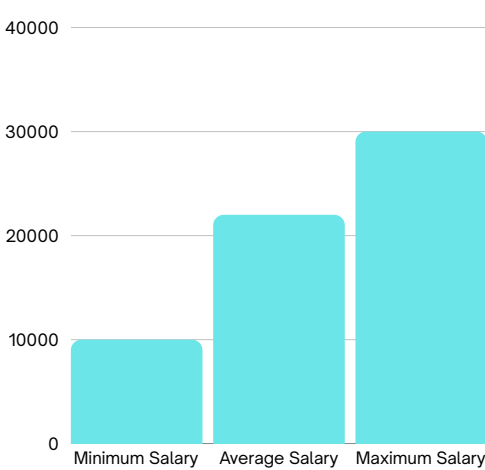
GENDER BREAKDOWN
Nursing Assistant 2 (FY2024)



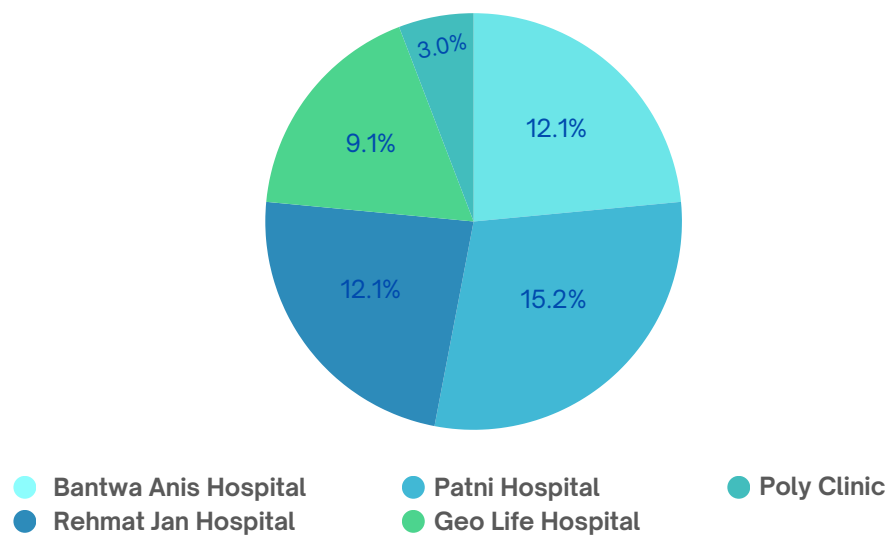
SALARY RANGE OF GRADUATES
Nursing Assistant 1 (FY2023)



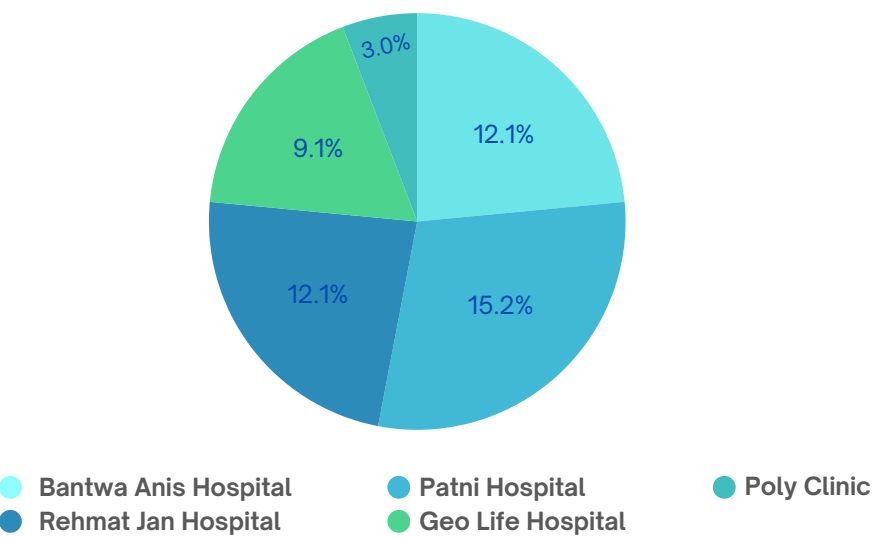
SALARY RANGE OF GRADUATES
Nursing Assistant 2 (FY2024)



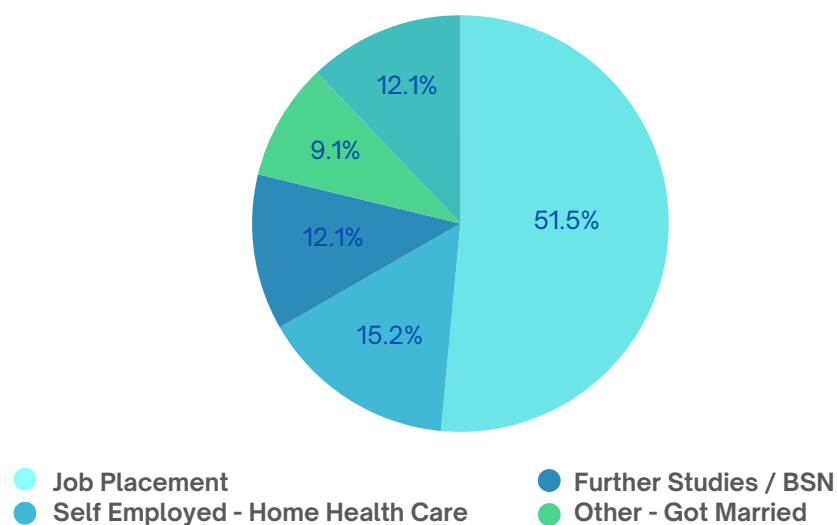
EMPLOYER BREAKDOWN



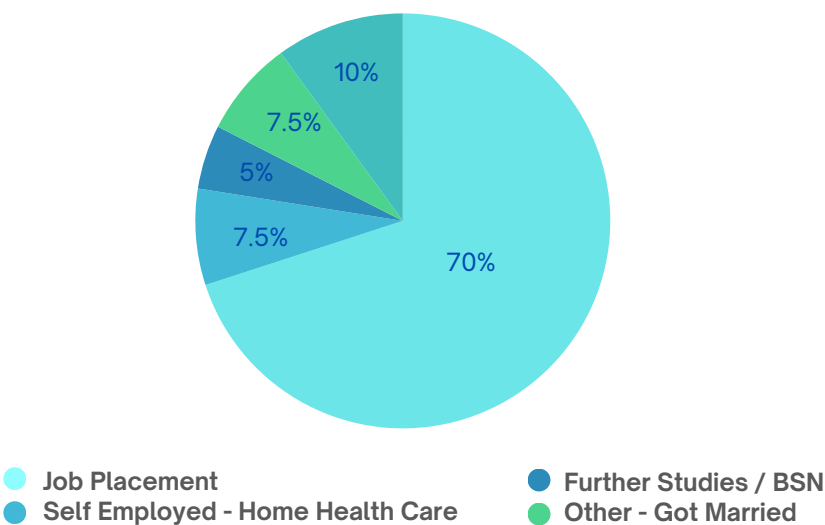
